Its primary aim is to improve health and social care services for local people. Volunteer roles are open to anyone who lives in Brent, with a passion for improving health and social care. You will be asked to:

- > Agree to have a full DBS check for certain projects, such as Enter and View
- > Be willing to travel to other parts of London for meetings and events

Healthwatch Volunteer Role Description

About the role:

Engaging with local people and building relationships with their communities is at the heart of Healthwatch Brent's approach to improving health and social care services. We want to reach the most disadvantaged and seldom heard groups, to make sure their voices are heard. To help us do this, we are recruiting a team of volunteers for our outreach and engagement activities.

Key responsibilities

- > To promote Healthwatch Brent by engaging with local people and community groups
- > To gather views about health and social care services in Brent from local people and community groups
- > To accurately report the views you gather to Healthwatch Brent
- > To feed-back information from Healthwatch Brent to people and groups in a way that is easily understood
- > To investigate issues of particular concern through discussions with local people and community groups under the guidance of the Volunteer Officer
- > To contribute to the organisation of events
- > To attend local events and meetings
- > To maintain an active interest the work and activities of Healthwatch Brent
- > To undertake ongoing training as required
- > To keep a record of expenses and submit them monthly
- > To commit to the time required to fulfil the role
- > To inform the Healthwatch Brent office in a timely fashion if you cannot keep to a commitment required by the role



What we look for in volunteers

- Good local knowledge
- > The ability to connect with a wide range of individuals and community groups, and to support them in voicing their opinions
- > The ability to present information to different audiences
- > The ability to separate your experiences from other people's issues and to present the views of those you represent without bias
- > Willingness to ask for support and to accept guidance
- > Language skills in addition to English are highly desirable

- Non-judgemental
- Committed to the practical application of equal opportunities
- Reliable and trustworthy
- > Respectful, supportive and empathetic when dealing with others
- > Motivated to learn and develop new skills
